STARTER. ‘WHO ARE YOU?’/‘WHAT IS THIS?’/‘TIME AND DATES’/‘AT HOME’/‘WHAT CAN YOU DO?’- ‘GIVING INSTRUCTIONS’.

VOCABULARY: countries and nationalities; cardinal numbers; school objects; school subjects;

days/months/seasons; ordinal numbers; house and furniture; abilities.

GRAMMAR: subject pronouns; present simple: be; question words; plurals; this/these-that/those;

prepositions of place; prepositions of time; there is-there are; some-any, can; the imperative.

FUNCTIONS: giving personal information; asking/telling the time; giving instructions.

UNIT 1. ‘STRONG BONDS’

VOCABULARY: family members; appearance; character adjectives; types of families; learning to learn: opposites; idioms: families.

GRAMMAR: have got; possessive adjectives; possessive ‘S; who/whose; object pronouns.

FUNCTIONS: introducing people: greetings/personal questions; describing people.

SILLS AND CULTURE: ‘Family life: a celebration’.

UNIT 2. ‘ROUND THE CLOCK’

VOCABULARY: daily routine and free time activities; chores; learning to learn: collocations; idioms: free-time activities.

GRAMMAR: present simple; adverbs and expressions of frequency; question words.

FUNCTIONS: inviting and making arrangements: accepting/refusing an invitation.

SKILLS AND CULTURE: ‘Does social media make you anxious?’.

UNIT 3. 'TASTES'

VOCABULARY: food and drink; portions and containers; food preparation, ways to cook.

GRAMMAR: countable and uncountable nouns; some/any/no; how much...? /how many...? / a lot of/much/many – (a) few/ (a) little; too much/too many/ (not) enough.

FUNCTIONS: ordering food

UNIT 4. 'ON TARGET'

VOCABULARY: sports; go/play/do + sport; sport venues; sports equipment; idioms: sports.

GRAMMAR: can; verbs + -ing form/infinitive/base form; possessive adjectives and pronouns.

FUNCTIONS: expressing preferences.

UNIT 5. 'LOOKING GOOD'

VOCABULARY: clothes, accessories and footwear; clothes and prices; materials and patterns; jewellery and accessories;

GRAMMAR: present continuous; present simple vs present continuous;

FUNCTIONS: shopping: talking about clothes /asking about and saying prices.

SKILLS AND CULTURE: 'Spend it or save it?' (British teenagers' spending habits).
